

FAQ

Q: Do we need to clean the vehicles if we drive down a clay road next to a field?

A: No, you have not entered agricultural land.

Q: Do we need to clean the exterior of the vehicle if we have driven on a farm lane?

A: Yes, you have entered agricultural land. Spray off wheels and wheel wells before exiting the agricultural land with disinfectant. If vehicle is very dirty, take the vehicle through a car wash. Best protocol is to avoid driving on farm lanes if possible.

Q: Will the disinfectant damage footwear?

A: Yes, and no. It will not damage rubber boots but there is evidence that repeated applications will or could damage work boots. Avoid wearing work boots in agricultural land.

Q: The farmer's say don't bother cleaning and disinfecting. What do we do?

A: Still follow the prescribed protocol.
