The PEI Watershed Alliance is contracted by the federal government to assist in conducting the 2 Billion Tree Project in the Province of Prince Edward Island. The Alliance is seeking to fill two seasonal student positions who will assist in the data collection and field operations of this project. The duties will consist of working closely with the 2 Billion Tree Program Coordinator and the Forest Technician to gather GPS coordinates, property information, and organize outreach material.

Duties:

- Fill the planting activity form.
- Help draft and present outreach material to watershed groups, communities and landowners.
- Coordinates site visits with project lead.

Requirements:

- Ability to organize and meet deadlines.
- Must be in highschool or a relevant post-secondary program.
- Valid driver's license and access to reliable vehicle.

Assets:

- Experience using Garmin GPS.
- Native plant identification.

Term:

- June 12th – September 1st, 2023

Remuneration:

- 37.5 hours/week at a rate of pay of \$19.00/hour + MERCS.
- Reimbursement for use of personal vehicle at provincial rate (currently \$0.52 per kilometer).
